•	Avoid talking loudly and	
	watch your teacher so	
	you know when the	
	lesson is about to start.	

- Stop any conversations straight away. You can 2. continue it later if you want to.
- Make eye contact. Your facial expressions will let your teacher know that you are listening.
- Remember not to call out even when your teacher asks the class a question. Put your hand up instead.
- Try to avoid getting distracted by others and definitely don't distract them.
- Answer and ask questions to show your teacher how well you have listened.
